paint booth protection mask

CHARACTERISTICS

BOOTH MASK is a water based, sprayable masking that protects spray booth surfaces from paint overspray. The liquid material dries to a clear and tack free film protecting the surface from overspray and solvents. The protective film remains chrystal clear for a long time and does not yellow. Therefore it does not affect the lighting conditions in the booth. After ca. 3 months or ca. 150 paint applications the film can be easily washed off with water.

BOOTH MASK is biodegradable.

APPLICATION

BOOTH MASK is used for protecting the booth against overspray. Booth walls and lamps can be sprayed and protected with BOOTH MASK. It is also suitable for protecting paint benches and other equipment from overspray and drips.

HANDLING

Application:

The walls of the booth should be clean, or newly painted, so as to ensure optimum lighting conditions. Ensure that all surfaces are completely dry. Apply a thick coat to the walls of the booth and the lights. After ca. 10 minutes apply a second coat to areas where there is a high degree of overspray. Avoid runs and drips. Allow BOOTH MASK to dry completely.

ATTENTION:

In case of newer cabins with bare aluminium door- and window frames adhesion problems may arise!

Tools:

BOOTH MASK should be applied with a spray gun suitable for water based materials. Recommended nozzle size: 1.8 - 2.2 mm. Booth Temperature: approx.: 21°C

Removing / Cleaning:

Turn off all power to booth lamps and electrical outlets. BOOTH MASK can be removed in the following two ways:

- 1. From smooth walls BOOTH MASK can be peeled off as a film.
- 2. On rough surfaces such as concrete, stone or cement render it is recommended that BOOTH MASK is washed off with a pressure washer.

Ensure all surfaces are dry before re-applying BOOTH MASK. Avoid overspray with water to walls that are already treated with BOOTH MASK.

For the protection of the booth floor as well as grills we recommend our product

DUST KEEPER.



Efficiency: The coating should be renewed after ca. 3 months or 150 paint applications.

Otherwise it may be difficult to remove the BOOTH MASK film.
